Year 8 EDUCATION OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM (EOTC) Programme:

Area 3 on 25 – 27 October

Learning doesn't only happen in the classroom! The Year 8 EOTC programme for your child takes place in Week 2 or 3 of Term 4 (when the Year 7s are at camp). The theme of EOTC is **challenge, recreation and peer support** based on the NZC Key Competencies of *thinking and solving problems, participating and contributing in a group, managing self and relating to others*. All the outdoor activities are run by trained staff who will be teaching the basic skills for the activities so that all students enjoy a positive experience while developing personal and physical skills.

The cost for all activities and transport is \$115 which is due to be paid by 20 October. Payments may be made in the following ways:
