- Monitor and record student progress using a variety of planned assessment procedures.
- Use a variety of teaching and learning styles and strategies, which are appropriate to the needs of the students and the physical environment.
- Plan their work thoroughly in accordance with school procedures and identified student needs.
- Regularly engage in learning conversations focused on student achievement.
- Identify barriers to learning for students, and implement strategies to address these.
- Use a thematic/integrated approach to integrate learning areas where practical and efficient.
- Undertake professional development as the necessary foundation for successful curriculum delivery.
- Focus on working collaboratively with other teachers and students.
